Using EndNote with SFX

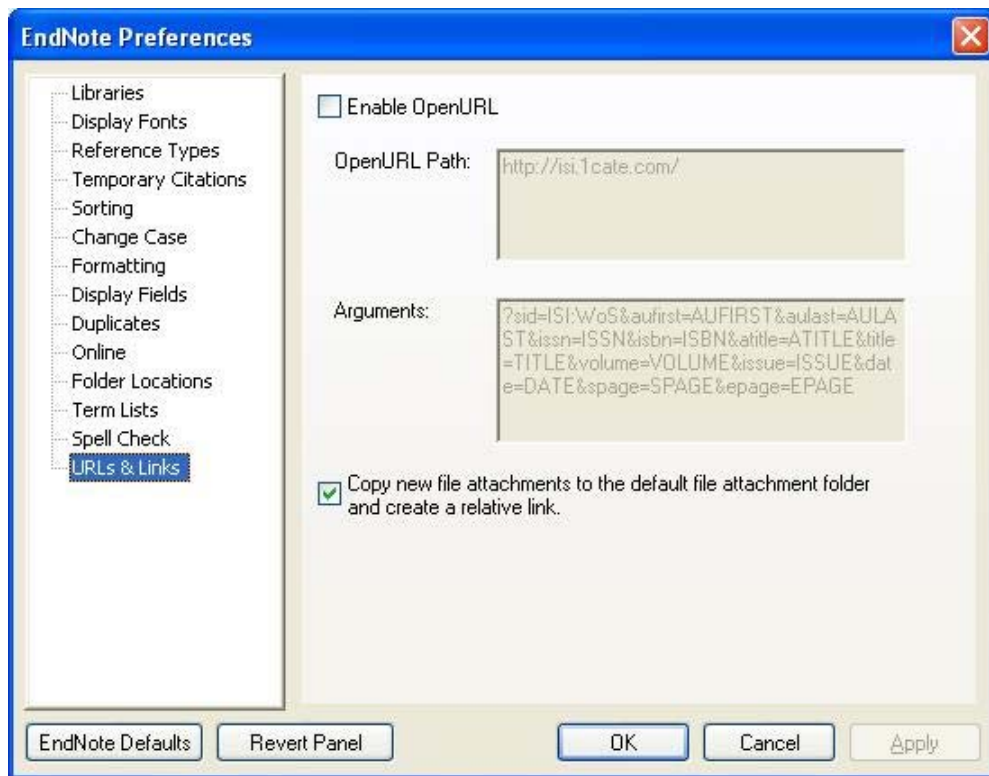
EndNote allows you to use SFX technology, which EndNote calls OpenURL, to search the library's electronic resources for the full text of articles whose details are stored in your EndNote library.

First, you must enable the **SFX (OpenURL)** function.

- Open EndNote.
- Click on **Edit | Preferences**.



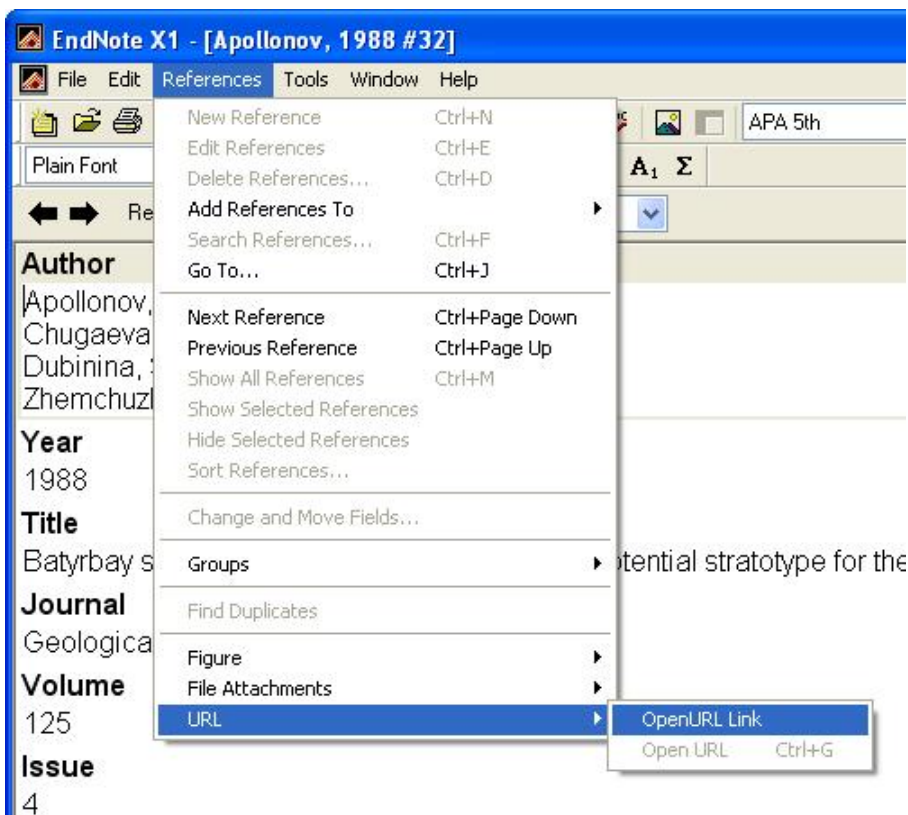
- Scroll down the list on the left side and highlight **URLs & Links**.
- Click on the **Enable OpenURL** box.



- Delete any URLs in the **OpenURL Path** text box and enter: <http://ezproxy.acu.edu.au:2048/login?url=http://cooe.unilinc.edu.au:9003/acu> (It's easiest to copy the text from this webpage with **CTRL-C** and paste it into the box with **CTRL-V**.)
- Leave the text in the **Arguments** box alone.
- Click on **OK**.

Now you can search for the full text of any reference.

- Open your EndNote library.
- **Double-click** on a reference to open it.
- Click on **References | URL | OpenURL Link**.



- SFX checks the available databases to see if the full text for this article is available. If it is, it will indicate where.
- Choose which **source** to access the full text from.
- SFX will locate the **full text** and display it on the screen.
