Requirements for the Degree

To complete a Bachelor of Teaching/Bachelor of Arts degree you must complete a total of 32 units.

Professional Studies (8 units)

This involves the four teaching studies units EDTS416 *Teaching and Classroom Management 1(S)*, EDTS416 *Teaching and Classroom Management 2(S)*, EDFD307 *Educational Assessment* and EDTS103 *Children with Special Needs 1*. Together with 4 curriculum units, two each for your two teaching subjects for a total of **8** units.

Educational Studies (8 units)

The Education Studies major is a sequence of **8** units. This component covers key areas in learning educational theory to introduce students to the language, concepts and understandings of practice within the field of education.

Arts Sequences (16 units)

These enable individual students to choose to study two or three disciplines in the liberal arts in conjunction with the Bachelor of Arts program. Students are required to take studies in **two** discipline areas that correlate with curriculum studies in those two areas. Students can complete either:

1 Arts major plus 2 Arts minors

or

1 Arts major plus a major in Theological Studies.

What are a Major and a Minor?

A Major is an approved sequence of units in one discipline or approved interdisciplinary area totalling at least 8 units, normally including at least 1 unit at Introductory level and at least 6 units at Advanced level.

A Minor is an approved sequence of units in one discipline or approved interdisciplinary area totalling at least 4 units, normally including at least 1 unit at Introductory level and at least 2 units at Advanced level.

HOW TO SELECT UNITS

1. You must select one of the units:

EDFD112 *Children at Risk*

Description As awareness of the nature and severity of risks to which children may be exposed in home and society grows, the role of the teacher in identifying potential risks and assisting children and the school system to cope with real-risk situations is important. This unit looks at sources and types of risk and how the teacher, school and community can cooperate with child and family to foster a positive sense of worth and ability.

EDFD207 *Social Justice and Education or*

Description We are all aware of examples of injustice in our immediate world, as well as inequalities on a global scale. Justice has become a key issue in modern society. To deepen the awareness of injustice and to propose action to produce a just society is an educational task. This unit considers both the theory and practice of justice in today's world..

EDFD210 *Global Perspectives in Education.*

Description This unit provides experiences that enable students to see the world from the perspectives of other cultures and foster attitudes of curiosity, sensitivity, tolerance and empathy. Students will develop an understanding of balanced social and economic development and a concern for the global environment that encourages active participation in the achievement of peace and justice.

EDSS100 *Australia in An Asian Context*

Description This unit is an introduction to Australia's interaction with the complexity and diversity of Asia from various perspectives. The unit broadly surveys some of the major cultural, social and economic developments which have shaped the interactions between Australia and selected Asian nations over time. A multi-disciplinary approach is adopted.

EDAC219 *Advocacy, Power and Empowerment*

Description This unit will assist students to understand the role and importance of advocacy in the lives of people with disabilities. Various forms of advocacy will be identified and critiqued, and students will actively research the utility of different sorts of advocacy. Concepts of power and empowerment will be examined, and their relevance to people with disabilities and their supporters will be addressed. A major focus of this unit is on assisting students to gain a practical understanding of advocacy and empowerment for and by people with disabilities.
